Basic Rules:

- 1) Grants are made ONLY to State of California public school teachers of K-12 grades (including special education teachers). While we recognize that there are lots of alternative programs with very deserving educators, our budget does not allow us to go outside this parameter at this time.
- 2) Previous recipients are not eligible. A list of all previous recipients will be published on the website mentioned above. The list is also available by calling our hot line.
- 3) In addition to the basic information, each and every nomination must include some narrative about why the nominee meets EACH of the six criteria listed. Each narrative should be limited to a maximum of 200 words (that is, 200 words or less for criterion one, 200 words or less for criterion two, and so forth).
- 4) Nominations are NOT carried forward to the following year. Any nominee who did not receive a grant is eligible for the next year's review, but a new nomination must be submitted on his or her behalf.
- 5) No nominations will be returned. If you wish to have a copy, please make and save it before you submit the nomination.
- 6) Unless we have specific instructions otherwise, the name of the person submitting the nomination will be made available to the nominee and the school principal. We hope you would be pleased to have them know you thought enough of them to submit the nomination!

Basic Advice:

- Clarity and conviction count more than eloquence. (Submissions by children will have spelling and grammar and other child-like mistakes overlooked.)
- Multiple submissions for a single nominee do not enhance or detract from that nominee's chances of receiving a grant.
- Other people are usually better at singing our praises than we are at singing our own, but you may nominate yourself if you like.
- Timeliness and thoroughness are critical. Submissions received after March 15 **will not be reviewed**. Incomplete submissions **will not be reviewed**.
