## Referrals for Annual G.A.T.E. Testing

The identification process for the Gifted and Talented Program will begin on January 11, 2010. Students in grades 3<sup>rd</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> are eligible to participate.

Students may be referred by either a parent or a classroom teacher. You may obtain referral forms from your school office starting January 11, 2010 or on the district website. All referrals must be received in the District Office no later than February 11, 2010.

If a teacher initiates the referral, our office will contact the parent for their form. If a parent initiates the referral, the office will contact the teacher for their form and supporting documents.

If you are already identified as a GATE student in our district, even if you are not participating in the program, there is no need to go through the referral process again.

If you are currently participating in the program as a High Achiever, and wish to test to be identified GATE, please take part in the process.

Preliminary data will be reviewed during the week of February 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 and those students eligible to go on to testing will be notified. Presently, testing is scheduled for Saturday morning, March 6, 2010.
